Pension records show he was wounded in leg at Missionary Ridge, Tenn. Nov. 25, 1863, and was at Calhoun County, Ala., wounded near the close of the war.

Davis, David Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Trenton, Ga. Sept. 8, 1863. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government at Rock Island, Ill. and enlisted in U. S. Army for frontier service Oct. 6, 1864.

Davis, Ephraim Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Chattanooga, Tenn. Sept. 28, 1863. Died at Camp Douglas, Ill. Apr. 11, 1864. Buried there.

Davis, William
Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Resaca, Ga. May 15, 1864. Released at Camp Morton, Ind. May 20, 1865. Appears on rolls of Cos. G, and H, this regiment but no record of transfer found.

Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. July 3, 1863. Received at City Point, Va. July 6, 1863. No later record.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862.
Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Edward's Station, Miss. May 17, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. July 3, 1863. Exchanged at City Point, Va. July 6, 1863. Furloughed from Ocmulgee Hospital at Macon, Ga., with asthma, Nov. 11, 1864. No later record.

Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862.
Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Deserted. Reported to Union lines at Bridgeport, Ala. Nov. 3, 1863. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government at Louisville, Ky. Nov. 12, 1863, and sent to be released north of Ohio River.

Fryar, Zebedee A. Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Died of smallpox in Military Prison at Alton, Ill. Aug. 23, 1863.

Ganger, A. F. Private May 17, 1862
Goss, Andrew Private May 17, 1862
In Chattanooga, Tenn. hospital Dec. 31, 1862.
Captured at Sand Mountain, GA. Mar. 18, 1864. Paroled at Camp Chase, O. and transferred to City Point, Va. for exchange Feb. 25, 1865.

Goss, Frederick Private May 17, 1862
Pension records show he was wounded in eye,

resulting in loss of sight, at Marietta, Ga. June 1864.

Goss, James M.

Enlisted as a private in Co. E, 8th Regt. Ga. State Troops Nov. 7, 1861. Discharged Feb. 9, 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Sand Mountain, Ga. Mar. 18, 1864. Died of typhoid fever at Camp Chase, O. Aug. 28, 1864. Grave #224, Camp Chase Confederate Cemetery.

Goss, John Private May 17, 1862

Captured at Baker's Creek, Miss. May 16, 1863. Paroled at Fort Delaware, Del. July 3, 1863. Received at City Point, Va. July 6, 1863. An exchanged prisoner at Richmond, Va. July 23, 1863. No later record.

Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. Captured at Dalton, Ga. May 13, 1864. Released at Camp Morton, Ind. May 20, 1865.

Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Hale, John S.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government at Louisville, Ky.
Nov. 25, 1863, and sent north of Ohio River.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State
Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862.
Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. GA
Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss.
July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No
later record.

Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and
paroled there July 15, 1863. No later record.

Killian, Lott Private Dec 16, 1862
Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and
paroled there July 8, 1863. Wounded, date and place
not given. Admitted to C.S.A. General Hospital #11,
at Charlotte, N. C. wounded in right leg, Jan. 15,
1865, and died Mar. 15, 1865.

Killian, Noah Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Nickajack Creek (also shown as
Marietta and Kennesaw), Ga. July 5, 1864. Released
at Camp Douglas, Ill. May 16, 1865.

Manning, Amos S. Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and
paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Mason, Gilbert M. Private May 17, 1862
Deserted. Admitted within the lines, Dept. of
Cumberland, a Confederate deserter, and took oath
of allegiance to U. S. Government at Nashville,
Tenn. Dec. 21, 1863. Released at Louisville, Ky.
and sent north Dec. 24, 1863.

Mason, James W. Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and
released there July 8, 1863. Deserted. Admitted
within the lines, Dept. of Cumberland, a
Confederate deserter, and took oath of allegiance
to U. S. Government at Nashville, Tenn. Dec. 21,
1863. Released at Louisville, Ky. and sent north
Dec. 24, 1863.

Mattison, Wesley W.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. "Deserted to Union lines while a paroled prisoner."

Maxwell, Alias Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Deserted. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government Dec. 13, 1863, and was forwarded north of Ohio River.

Miller, John T.

Enlisted as a private in Co. K, 10th Regt. Ga. State Troops Dec. 16, 1861. Mustered out May 1862. Enlisted as a private in Co. F, 34th Regt. Ga. Inf. May 17, 1862. Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Moore, James Private May 17, 1862
Deserted. Took oath of allegiance to U. S. Government at Chattanooga, Tenn. Apr. 22, 1864.

Morris, Thomas J. Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. No later record.

Murphy, Jesse Parker Private May 17, 1862
Captured at Marietta, Ga. July 3, 1864. Remarks: "Claims to have been loyal". Was forced to enlist in Rebel Army and deserted to avail himself of amnesty." Died of disease at Camp Douglas, Ill. Aug. 24, 1864. Grave #1297, Chicago City Cemetery. More information may be available at the wonderful Chicago Historical Society downtown Chicago.

Captured at Vicksburg, Miss. July 4, 1863, and paroled there July 8, 1863. "Applied to C.S. Secy. of War for permission to go to Murray County, Ga. to raise a company of Negroes for

service in C. S. Army, Apr. 20, 1865."
