THE FIRST ASSEMBLY OF GOD CHURCH

In September, 1920, a small group of people began what is now known as the First Assembly of God Church in Senath, Missouri. It was erected at its present site, at the corner of Hope and State Streets. The church was set in order and officially chartered in April, 1921. There were 17 charter members.

Mrs. Essie Vowell, the last charter member, died in 1981.

Rev. W. V. Kneisley was the first pastor.

The new church building now serving the congregation, was erected in 1978.



FAITH BAPTIST CHURCH

The Faith Baptist Church was organized June 15, 1969 with thirty-three members present. They have four active deacons and two nominees for deacons. The average attendance in Sunday School is 55, 40 in Church

Training. The new pastor is Rose Lester Thompson.

There are three scheduled services a week, with a visitation program on Thursday night.
