## Senath Lodge #513 AF & AM

Senath Lodge # 513 AF & AM was chartered October 22, 1902.

On December 3, 1902, Right Worshipful Brother J. R. Pool, District Deputy Grand Master, installed the first officers of the Lodge as follows: Worshipful Master - A.A. Caneer; Senior Warden - A.N.B. Wilson; Junior Warden - P. A. Frie; Treasurer - R. C. Bruce; Secretary - W. R. Browning; Senior Deacon - E. V. McGrew; Junior Deacon - W. C. Biggs; Chaplain - Van Rice; Senior Steward - W. T. Ford; Junior Steward - W. H. Douglass; and Tiler - F. M. Watson.

Until February 24, 1906, Lodge was held in a new brick building according to the minutes, did not state where

the building was located. Rent was paid to J. W. White. In 1906, the second floor of the Christian Church's frame building was rented. It was located where the Church of Christ is now located. Sometime later Lodge was held on the second floor of the Joe Kamp Building, and in late 1930 the Lodge moved to its present location in the old City Hall building.
