WHEREAS *John Worley, of Scott County, Missouri,*

has deposited in the GENERAL LAND OFFICE of the United States, a Certificate of the REGISTER OF THE LAND OFFICE of *Jackson* whereby it appears that full payment has been made by the said *John Worley,*

according to the provisions of

the Act of Congress of the 24th of April 1820, entitled "An Act amending further provision for the sale of the Public Lands," for the North West quarter of the South West quarter of Section Number, in Township Twenty nine, North, of Range fourteen East, in the District of Lands subject to sale at *Jackson, Missouri,* containing forty acres,

according to the official plat of the survey of the said Lands, returned to the General Land Office by the SURVEYOR GENERAL, which said tract has been purchased by the said *John Worley,*

NOW KNOW YE, That the

United States of America, in consideration of the Premises, and in conformity with the several acts of Congress, in such case made and provided, HAVE GIVEN AND GRANTED, and by these presents DO GIVE AND GRANT, unto the said *John Worley,*

and to his heirs, the said tract above described: AND HAVE AND SHALL have, together with all the rights, privileges, immunities, and appurtenances of whatsoever nature, thereunto belonging, unto the said *John Worley,*

and to his heirs and assigns forever.
