ISDUP is sponsoring a Handcart Pioneer Poetry and Short Story Contest! Here are the submission guidelines: All poems and short stories must be original pieces based on factual handcart accounts. Short story submissions should be no more than one thousand words. The format required is 12 dpi, double spaced. Please include the names and dates of actual events. Judging of the pieces will be based upon the following: clarity of thought, continuity and judicious use of language, grammar, syntax, verb structure, readability; and impact of story content. Include biographical information of author, including birth date, education, and DUP heritage. The top two poetry and short story entries will be published in *Legacy* and possible other publications and become the property of ISDUP. Non-cash prizes will be awarded to the first and second place winners in both categories at the International Convention in October.
