The Guernsey County Genealogical Society was chartered as Chapter #5 of the Ohio Genealogical Society in 1969. The society office and research library is located at 125 N. 7th Street, Cambridge, OH.

First and Pioneer Families is a vital part of the society, First Families began in 1982 and Pioneer Families had its' beginning in 1995. Both groups are going strong and accepting new members annually.

The First and Pioneer Families induction ceremonies and banquet are held annually on the first Saturday in May.

Among the many great things the society has to offer is its great research library. A large collection of Guernsey County original court records are housed within the holdings of the GCCOGS archives. These records include original documents from the Probate Court (Wills, Estate Records, and Guardianship Records etc.), Common Plea Court Records (Original Journals, Appearance Dockets, Record Books, Criminal Dockets and Files, Naturalization Dockets etc.), County Recorder (Land Records, Military Discharge Records, etc.), County Auditor (Tax Records, Licenses, etc.). Just to mention a few of the original records accessible to the public by visiting our library.

In addition to the above court records GCCOGS also has a large collection of research material covering all of Guernsey County including Church records, county histories, obituaries, family histories, Cambridge and Byesville city directories, copies of original death certificates covering the time period of 1913 and part of the 1950's, cemetery readings for most of the county, interment records for Northwood, City and Founder's cemeteries located within Cambridge, Senecaville cemetery plot owners, census records covering most of south eastern Ohio,

Within the GCCOGS research library/archives, a large collection of materials is available for many of the central and southeastern Ohio counties including Noble, Washington, Belmont, Muskingum, Coshocton, Harrison, Monroe, and Tuscarawas counties.

The GCCOGS volunteers welcome all patrons and look forward to your visit to our research library. The library is open Tuesday, 1-4 pm, Wednesday, 10 am to 5 pm, Thursday, 1pm to 4 pm. To further assist our out of town members and patrons additional hours may be prearranged by appointment.
