Know all men by these presents that we, Edmond Davenport, Isaac Davenport and Enoch Davenport all of the County and State aforesaid do for the inconsideration, sum of twenty five pounds to each of us in hand paid, viz: twenty five pounds by Absolum Davenport, twenty five pounds by Rebin Davenport, or his guardian, and twenty five pounds by Lowes Davenport or her guardian, all heirs of George Davenport, deceased do bargain, sell, conveyed and confirm unto the said Absolum, Rewbin and Lowes Davenport, as aforesaid all our right, title, interest and claim of in and unto a certain piece or parcel of land lying in Hyde County it being a piece of land that our Father purchased of George Condrey as said deed will shew and which lands he, deceased, reserving to the use of our mother, Sarah Davenport, the use thereof during life or widowhood, with all houses, etc, thereto belonging or appertaining unto the said Absolum, Rewbin, and Lowes their heirs and assigns which said land we do covenant to warrant and defend from our heirs and assigns, the said lands contains one hundred acres, it being more or less, as witness our hands and seals this 20th day of September, 1799.

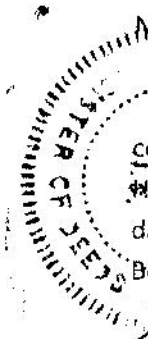
