 in Shamons in the State of Pennsylvania is seventeen  
 years of age five feet eight inches high light complexion blue eyes  
 sandy hair, and by occupation when enlisted a Farmer During the last two  
 months said soldier has been unfit for duty 60 days. Because of disease  
of the lungs, which was contracted while in  
the line of his duty
