

# Rites Held For Mrs. Cisney

## Pioneer Resident of Community Passed Away at Home of Son at Magnet

Mrs. Marjory J. Cisney, widow of the late Stephen S. Cisney, passed away Aug. 19 at the home of her son, Kinley, in Magnet at the age of 84 years, two months, and 25 days.

Marjory J. Stephen was the daughter of Francis and Lamzen and was born on May 25, 1858, and at the age of 11 she moved with her parents to Newark, Ind., where she was married to Stephen S. Cisney on Feb. 23, 1879. They moved to Layfayette, Ill., later on to Aurelia, Ia., for a few years, then on to Ainsworth, Nebr., then to Coleridge where they resided on their farm two miles north of town until the spring of 1917, when they retired and lived in Coleridge.

Mr. Cisney passed away in November, 1930, and Mrs. Cisney continued to live there until about a year ago, when she went to Magnet to stay with her son, Kinley.

She leaves to mourn her loss six sons, Earl of Fruita, Colo., Sid of Coleridge, Arlie of Eugene, Ore., Joe of New Plymouth, Idaho, Ernest of Randolph, and Kinley of Magnet; two daughters, Odessa (Mrs. Will Roberts) of Sioux City and Inez (Mrs. Fred Gibson) of Onawa, Ia.; 38 grandchildren, 44 great grandchildren, and one great great grandson.
