

Funeral on Monday For Sid Cisney, 85

Funeral services for Stephen Sidney Cisney, 85, were held Monday afternoon, Aug. 10 at the Smith-Wintz Funeral Home in Coleridge. Rev. Jesse Withee officiated. Mr. Cisney died at the Wayne hospital on Thursday, Aug. 6.

The son of Stephen and Marjorie Cisney, Stephen Sidney was born May 19, 1885 at Ainsworth. He moved with his family to a farm near Coleridge at the age of six years and lived in this community the remainder of his life.

On February 23, 1904 he was united in marriage to Emma Jane Henderson, who preceded him in death December 14, 1953. They farmed near Coleridge until 1943 when he retired and moved into Coleridge. He was a member of the Congregational Church.

Preceding him in death were his wife and two brothers, Earl and Ernest. Survivors include his children: Mrs. Roy B. (Grace) Anderson of Laurel, Stephen of Merced, Calif., Leslie of Jefferson, S. Dak., Giles of Denver, Colo., and Donald Bruce of Long Beach, Calif.; two sisters, Mrs. Odessa Roberts of Sioux City and Mrs. Inez Gibson of Onawa, Ia.; three brothers, Joseph of Caldwell, Ida., Arlee "Mike" of Eugene, Ore., and Kinley of Lincoln; and ten grandchildren.
