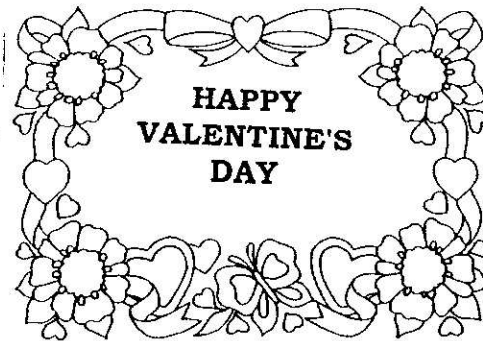

MEETING OF THE TOWN BOARD

Fremont, Jan 14th, 1869

9 February 2009
Mares Meeting Room 7p.m.
1722 East 19th -Fremont NE

Board met pursuant to adjournment.

On motion A G Brugh was appointed Clerk of the Board during the absence of E H Barnard.

The minutes of last meeting were read and on motion were corrected by noting the allowance of F M Wirminghaus's bill for surveying of \$63, which after said correction were approved.

Moved that a tax of one cent on the dollar valuation be levied on all the lots within the limits of the Town of Fremont and its additions, and for a basis of valuation, the valuation of said lots to be the same as the valuation thereof made at the last assessment by the county, and the funds arising from this levy shall be a general fund. Motion carried.

On motion, A G Brugh was appointed to levy said tax, and Nelson Toncray to collect said tax within thirty days.

On motion W H Munger was appointed as an Attorney for the Town Board.

On motion Drs Crabbs & Bear were awarded the contract of building 1500 feet of sidewalks more or less on Broad, 6th and E streets(as per advertisement) for the sum of \$1 per longitudinal foot(as per bid) provided said parties give the necessary bonds for the faithful performance, of the contract said bonds being estimated at \$2000.

A petition from A A Greves with the necessary signers was presented to the Board for the sale of spiritous liquors in the town of Fremont.

On motion the petition was granted and bonds of said Greves accepted, and the clerk directed to issue the necessary license upon the presentation of the proper receipt.

GENTLEMEN - We are sorry to inform you that the building of the Logan creek bridge upon the terms the Commissioners desire cannot be carried out, we therefore relinquish the same.

Moved that Ray & Flor be relinquished from their contract, provided they pay all expense to the county by virtue of said contract. Motion carried.

On motion the commissioner appointed to view a line of road from where the road running from West Point in a direction to Fremont, ends on the west side of the Elkhorn river to Fremont, was directed to proceed to view and said road and the expense of the same would be allowed.
